Busing, Hours and Meals for Pre-K Students

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

1. Busing is available to transport AM students to school in the morning and transport PM students home in the afternoon. There is no busing in the middle of the day. Full day students can be transported to and from school.
2. UPK students will be unloaded from the bus at 8:40. All others will be taken into school at 9:00. Parents and caregivers of non-bussed students must sign students in. PM students will begin school at 12:45. Bused students will be dismissed at 3:25 and all others at 3:15.
3. Full day students will receive breakfast and lunch beginning the 1st day of school. Half day students will receive a snack.
4. Students must be 4 years of age to ride the bus because of seat belt laws. Once your child turns 4, you can contact the transportation department at 315-341-2900 for your child to be transported.
5. Parents are not allowed to change pick up and/or drop off location unless there has been a change of address.
6. In-city UPK students will be dropped off on street corners. Children must have someone at drop off to meet them. Children will not be dropped off if no one is there to meet them.
7. Parents and caregivers of non-bused students cannot park in loading zones.

Adhering to these rules will make a smooth transition for your UPK child.
