

Coaching Certification Process for Certified Teacher Coaches:

Individuals that hold a valid NYS teacher certificate do not need to apply for a Temporary or Professional Coaching License. (This includes pupil personnel staff including counselors, school psychologists and administrators)

Physical Education teachers must have the following:

- Valid First Aid certificate
- Valid CPR certificate

Teachers of subjects other than Physical Education must have the following:

- Valid First Aid certificate
- Valid CPR certificate
- Philosophy, Principles and Organization of Athletics in Education or meet the requirements for NFHS Accredited Interscholastic Coach Certificate (AIC – Level 1) **within 2 years of their initial appointment as a coach**
- Health Sciences Applied to Coaching and Theory & Techniques of Coaching (Sport Specific) or complete the requirements for NFHS Certified Interscholastic Coach Certificate (CIC – Level 2) **within 5 years of their initial appointment.**
- Workshop - Child Abuse Identification
- Workshop - School Violence Intervention and Prevention
- Workshop – DASA (either the 6 hour workshop or the required yearly school district training)
- Fingerprint Clearance
