



Student Expectations Contract 2023-2024 **7 WEST TEAM**

As a student at the Oswego Middle School for the 2023-2024 school year I have read and understand each of the following expectations:

HALLWAY and STAIRWELL EXPECTATIONS:

- I will enter the school through the Main Doors each Morning.
- I will WALK on the RIGHT HAND side of the hallway/stairwell at all times.
- I will keep my hands and feet to myself at all times.
- I will use a normal voice level while in the hallway/stairwell at all times and I will not use inappropriate language at any time that I am in school.
- I understand that there is no reason for me to scream or raise my voice while I am at school.
- I will carry my planner at all times that I am in the hallway. I will use the hall passes that are in planner whenever I go to Bathroom, etc.
- I will get to all of my classes on time.
- I understand that if I do not get to my classes on time I may be caught in a 'Hallway Sweep' and be assigned After – School Detention.

- I will hold doors open for people who are behind me.
- I will speak to people by saying 'hello' or 'hi' when I see them in the hallway.
- I will be polite and respectful to other students and adults at all times.

LOCKER EXPECTATIONS:

- I will use the locker that has been assigned to me ONLY.
- I will be the only person who knows my Locker Combination.
- I will open and close my locker calmly at all times.
- I will only use magnetic decorations and decorations that are easily removed in my locker.
- My Backpack and/or Cinch Sac and any outside clothing will be stored in my Locker at all time.
- I will keep my Cell Phone in my Locker at all time and it will be turned off.

- **I will ONLY go to my locker during the times assigned to my 7W Team as follows:**

- ✓ 1st Locker Visit is when you enter school in the morning – before 1st period
 - ✓ 2nd Locker Visit is before Lunch (5B)
 - ✓ 3rd Locker Visit is after Lunch (5B)
 - ✓ 4th Locker Visit is before PE (7B)
 - ✓ 5th Locker Visit is after PE (7B)
 - ✓ ON THE DAYS you DO NOT HAVE PE – get everything you need after lunch for the remainder of the day – there will be no more locker visits -
 - ✓ 6th Locker Visit is After School – at Dismissal - -after 9th Period
- *I will PLAN AHEAD for these visits to my locker and will take all items with me that I need at that time and until the next visit.*
 - *On the days that I DO NOT have PE I will not go to my locker I will go directly to Art, Music or my Enrichment Class.*

CAFÉ EXPECTATIONS:

- I will walk in a straight line with my classmates to and from the café. I get to go to my locker before and after lunch. I will be escorted to lunch and back from lunch by an OMS Teacher Assistant.
- I will enter the café and sit down immediately. If I have brought my lunch with me I can start eating.
- If I need to buy a School Lunch I will wait until my lunch table is called by one of the School Lunch Monitors to get in line.
- When I am in the café I will follow all instructions given by the School Lunch Monitors.
- I will line up when directed to do so at the end of the period and will walk back to my locker escorted by Teacher Assistants.
- I understand that if I am not able to follow all Café Expectations I will be assigned Lunch Detention in a separate location.

CHROMEBOOK EXPECTATIONS:

- I will be assigned a school – owned Chromebook that I will take full responsibility for.
- I will charge my Chromebook at home each evening and bring it with me to school each day.
- I will use the Chromebook Case that I am assigned for the Chromebook ONLY. NO SCHOOL SUPPLIES, etc will be put in this case.
- I will use my School – owned Chromebook for School Work ONLY.

I have read the above OMS Student Expectations and I understand them. I agree to do my part at OMS to *'Take Care of Myself, Take Care of Others and Take Care of my School'* at all times.

I understand that each of my Classroom teachers will review their Classroom Expectation. I will follow the individual Classroom Expectations at all times.
