THE ROLE OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION **Duties of the School Physician/Nurse Practitioner**

Policy # 1338

The school physician/nurse practitioner shall be appointed by the Board of Education. The duties of the school physician/nurse practitioner shall include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Performs professional medical services in the examination and care of school children; a)
- Performs routine examinations of school children to detect the presence of contagious diseases b) and physical defects;
- Serves as an on call member on the Committee on Special Education; c)
- d) Reports to the Board on school health services;
- Coordinates scheduling for physical examinations to all students participating in interscholastic e) athletics:
- Develops the program of health service in accordance with policies approved by the Board and as f) directed by the Superintendent of Schools;
- Conducts physical exams for all bus drivers and substitutes prior to employment and annually g) thereafter;
- h) Conducts physical exams for all new employees (instructional and non-instructional);
- i) Conducts a medical evaluation on any employee at the request of the Board of Education.
