

Jack Bobbett \$1500 Memorial Scholarship

Purpose:

To assist one (or two) graduating seniors who will attend a college in the Fall of 2022.

In honor of Jack Bobbett, a student we lost too soon, the Oswego Middle School National Junior Honor Society is proud to establish a scholarship in his memory. Jack embodied what it means to be a student leader and a contributing member of our school and community. He embraced the notion that you need to be the change you want to see in the world. Through his leadership and excellent character, Jack served as an example and inspiration to others to work hard and show kindness, and that is why we dedicate this scholarship in his memory.

Amount:

At the discretion of the Scholarship Committee there may be one (or two) awards of one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1500) which will be awarded this year to recipients prior to entering college, issued in August 2022.

Criteria:

- To be eligible for the award, the candidate must be accepted at an accredited college and be able to present evidence of acceptance when applying for the award. Please attach an acceptance letter to your application.
- Scholarship recipient will show a record of participation in School and Community Service.
- Scholarship recipient will show a record of involvement in extracurricular activities.
- Student with a future interest in or a record of broadcasting experience in high school (ex. WBUC) is preferred, but not required.
- Scholarship recipient will show a record of maintaining a history of Honor Roll.

Selection:

A committee representing the Jack Bobbett Memorial Scholarship will select the recipient(s) of the award. The award will be announced prior to graduation.

Deadline:

Submit the completed application to the National Junior Honor Society advisors at Oswego Middle School, by Friday, May 20, 2022. Applications should be postmarked by May 18, 2022 and mailed to:
