- Research shows that missing 10 percent of the school, or 18 days in most school districts, negatively affects a student's academic performance. That's just two days a month and that's known as chronic absenteeism.
- When students improve their attendance rates, they improve their academic prospects and chances for graduating high school!

All students will enter OMS and pass through our Open Gate System.


As a reminder, the following items must be removed from your backpack before passing through:



#### 7 EAST TEAM

As a student at the Osweep Middle School for the 2025-2026 school year I have read and understand each of the following expectations:

#### Arrival and Dismissal:

- . I will arrive at school on time and come to school every day unless I am ill.
- · I will be friendly and follow directions given by adults.
- I will use Voice Level 1. I understand that there is no reason to raise my voice or yell.
- · I will enter the school through the Main Doors each Morning and wait appropriately in line for the Open Gate Security System.
- . I will take my binder(s) out of my backpack so that I'm ready to go through the Open Gate Security system.
- . I will check into my homeroom immediately upon entering the building.
- I will go to the cafe ONLY if I need breakfast and will return to my homeroom in a timely manner.
- . I will bring any internet enabled device (i.e. cellphone, smart watch, etc) to my homeroom class and lock it in the cell phone locker.
- · I will acknowledge others when spoken to.
- I will keep my hands and feet to miself and respect others' personal space.
- · I will only bring school appropriate things into the building.

#### HALLWAY and STAIRWELL EXPECTATIONS:

- · I will use Voice Level 1 and appropriate language.
- . I will WALK on the RIGHT HAND side of the hallway/stairwell at all times.
- I will respect others' space and belongings, keeping my hands and feet to myself.
- I will carry all required materials for my classes.
- · I will get to all of my classes on time.
- I will be polite and respectful to other students and adults at all times.

#### LOCKER EXPECTATIONS:

- I will use the locker that has been assigned to me ONLY.
- · I will be the only person who knows my Locker Combination.
- · I will open and close my locker safely at all times.
- I will only use magnetic decorations and decorations that are easily removed in my locker.
- I will keep air pods/headphones in my locker unless directed otherwise.
- My Backpack and/or Circh Sac and any outside clothing will be stored in my locker at all times.
- . I will ONLY go to my locker during the times assigned to my 7 East. Team as follows:
  - ✓ When you enter school in the morning before 1st period
  - ✓ Before PE

#### **Arrival Procedures**

- Arrival Bell 7:25am
- Enter building through Open Gate and report to 1st pd or homeroom. (West team report to the highlighted class on your schedule)
- OMS Breakfast
- Late Pass is required for students arriving after 7:30 am
- Students riding a bike are to wear a helmet and plan to lock bike in racks in the courtyard
- No skateboards allowed
- Drop-off Procedures
  - Drop off ONLY in the "Loop" on the west side of the building
  - Do not drop off until 7:25

#### **Dismissal Procedures**

- Dismissal Bell 2:25pm
- Pick-Up Procedures
  - Pick-up ONLY in the "Loop" on the west side of the building
  - Walkers will be released after all busses have been called

- ➤ Late Bus 3:20pm
- Early pickups Note required including time you will pick student up
